"No Fisheries Sensitive Watersheds are included within FDU 1 and 2 as identified in Schedule 2 of the FPPR." is deleted and replaced with;

"No Fisheries Sensitive Watersheds are included within any FDU as identified in Schedule 2 of the FPPR."

8. Objectives Set by Government for Water in Community Watersheds (FPPR 8.2)

The Result or Strategy for Community Watersheds is amended as follows:

"No community watersheds are included within FDU 1 and 2." is deleted and replaced with;

"The Holder of this FSP will not construct a road or harvest a cutblock within a designated community watershed."

9. Measures to Prevent the Introduction & Spread of Invasive Plants

The following paragraph is added as preventative measures to combat the introduction and spread of invasive plant species;

"Logging and road construction contractors will be directed to inspect and remove shrub vegetation from logging/road construction equipment, and dispose of the vegetation in a manner that will prevent the further introduction or spread of species of plants that are considered invasive under the Invasive Plants Regulation."

10. Appendix 1 Stocking Standards

Non-Replaceable Forest License A87259 is added to Appendix 1.0 section 2.1.

Section 2.0 has been amended to include biogeoclimatic (BEC) variants: CWHds2 and CWHvm1.

Section 2.1 has been amended to include a six regeneration delay for all BEC variants.
